Biographical Note:

Professor King began his teaching career at The University of Colorado at Boulder in 1972. He taught one of the school's first black studies classes. Course offerings throughout his 40-year tenure included the politics and ethics of social research; African American scientists and inventors; blacks in the West; W. E. B. DuBois; and, Afro centric research methods.

He was a champion for increased minority enrollment and faculty representation at the University. He helped to start the National Council for Black Studies. His teaching portfolio minutely describes his academic journey.

He was the principal author of the curriculum to create a major in black studies in 1974. He had an unusual approach to teaching: “to help students find their own truths in the materials presented”.

Professor King is a member of the Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History (ASAALH); the National Congress of Black Faculty and the National Institute of Science.
